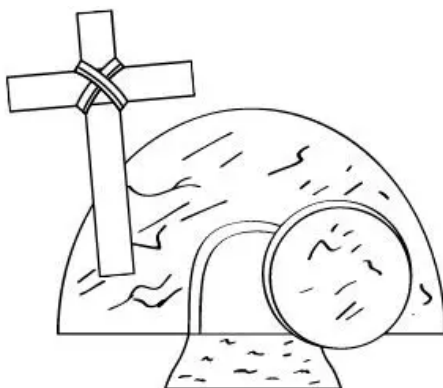
Worship Assistants

CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES

February 13, 2024

Members Present: Sue Mayer, Harvard Jaeck, Ruth Heilman, Rebecca Blum, Jerry Roust, Reinhard Riessen, Marilyn Anderson and Pastor Aaron Deutsch.

President Jerry Roust called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Devotions: Marilyn Anderson provided a devotion on 1 John 3:16 from Jesus Our Perfect Hope by Charles Stanley entitled "*Love Received and Given.*"

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made to approve the agenda. **M/S/P**

Minutes: January regular meeting minutes were approved and filed. **M/S/P**

Treasurer's Report: Report was presented and filed. It was noted that a sales tax credit will need to be returned to the Church for the stainless-steel table purchase as we are a tax-exempt entity.

Pastor's Report: Written report was provided and filed.

Committee Reports:

- **Benevolence/Stewardship:** A final decision was made to sponsor a full day of broadcasting on KJLY on October 31st which is Reformation Day. Resurrection Lutheran will receive 8 mentions throughout the day on the radio. We will try to annually request Reformation Day in years ahead.
- **Education/Evangelism/Outreach:** Report filed. No action items. The SOAPer Bowl donations went well and have been delivered. Resurrection Lutheran will prepare and serve a meal at the Connections homeless shelter in April. A Women's Retreat is being planned for May.
- **Personnel:** No meeting.
- **Property/Facility:** The EEO Committee is requesting a dry/erase board for the classroom that will be used for Sunday School. Pastor Aaron suggested that a portable board on wheels may be more versatile. Such a board will be ordered at the approximate cost of \$300. **M/S/P**
- **Worship:** Report filed. No action items currently.

Old Business: Pastor Aaron is working with Sound and Media Solutions out of Rochester on our audio/visual livestreaming issues and will be meeting with them on Thursday, February 15th to create a plan for moving forward. It appears the stainless-steel tables that were purchased for the downstairs kitchen had some damage done during transit and delivery. Contact was made with the vendor who apologized and indicated that they would give us 20% credit off the cost of the tables due to the defects and the Church Council felt this was acceptable. **M/S/P**

New Business: A membership request from Erika Pierson was received and gladly accepted. **M/S/P**

The meeting adjourned at 7:30PM and closed with the Lord's Prayer.
